

**Request for Proposals – Information Technology Managed Services
Questions and Answers
September 6, 2019**

The following questions were received by Klos Consulting, Inc.

Q1. Will Broward Partnership allow an on sight network review before our company submits a proposal?

A1. The Broward Partnership will conduct a site visit on Tuesday, September 10, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. at the Central Homeless Assistance Center (920 NW 7th Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33311) and at 11:00 a.m. at the North Homeless Assistance Center (1700 Blount Road, Pompano Beach, FL 33069). Attendance is not required.

Q2. Any special requirements our company needs to have to place a bid?

A2. Requirements are contained in the Request for Proposals. Additional requirements may be requested as part of the negotiation and/or prior to contract start date.

Q3. Is a woman owned company preferred?

A3. The RFP isn't prioritizing specific business types, but the Partnership encourages diversity among its contractor base.

Q4. Are you looking for a separate proposal for voice over IP?

A4. VOIP managed services should be factored into the proposal budget starting in June 2020. The Partnership is currently engaged with a VOIP managed care contractor until May 2020.

Q5. Is there a budget that you are currently working with?

A5. The agency budget is \$12 million and is listed on page 1 of the Request for Proposals. The agency seeks competitive pricing for IT Managed Services.
